Introduction:

- 1. The work of an evangelist is separate and apart from one's work as a Christian, requiring much of the one who desires its position. (2 Tim. 4:5)
- 2. Many today desire a career in preaching God's word but are unclear as to all of the responsibilities that come along with it.
- 3. Many congregations today have a good understanding of what is required of their preachers yet may not fully understand what they may require him to do.
